2.1 Application Forms need not be submitted physically at the University Office. Admission will be strictly in the online mode. Physical Presence of any candidate will not be entertained before or during the admission process.

- 3.2 (a) Reservations for SC / ST / OBC-A / OBC-B / PH/EWS candidates shall be applicable as per Government rules, directives, and constitutional provisions.
 (b) For candidates belonging to the SC and ST categories there will be, as mandated by the Government, a relaxation of the minimum eligibility criteria (cut-off percentage) by 10%. (Provided the candidate should achieve the qualifying marks in their respective Honours subjects).
- 3.3 Candidates who have graduated with required criteria in 2023 (previous year) and 2024 (current year) are eligible to apply for PG admission in all departments. Candidates who have graduated with required criteria in any year not earlier than 2020 can apply for PG admission in Pali and the subjects under TOL system.
- 3.4 Candidate should enter the marks obtained only in the HONOURS/CORE COURSE (IN CASE OF CBCS) SUBJECT.
- 3.5 Merit List will be prepared on the basis of marks obtained at graduation and the eligibility criteria prescribed at point 3.1.
- 3.6 After Publication of Merit List/s, the eligible candidates will have <u>to deposit</u> <u>required admission fees online within applicable cut-off date</u>. After successful payment, the candidate will be notified about the confirmation of his/her admission through Email/Download option at website.
- 3.7 Sports Quota relaxation of 5% would be available to Sportspersons who have participated at State Level and above competitions/events (Certificate issued by State/Central Government shall be required).
